

## **Healthy Habits for Kansas Kids Online Childhood Obesity Education Pilot Program**

The Kansas Chapter, American Academy of Pediatrics (KAAP) is looking for healthcare providers (MD, DO, PA, NP, NPN, RN, LPN, RD) to pilot and provide feedback for their childhood obesity online continuing education program and supporting materials.
